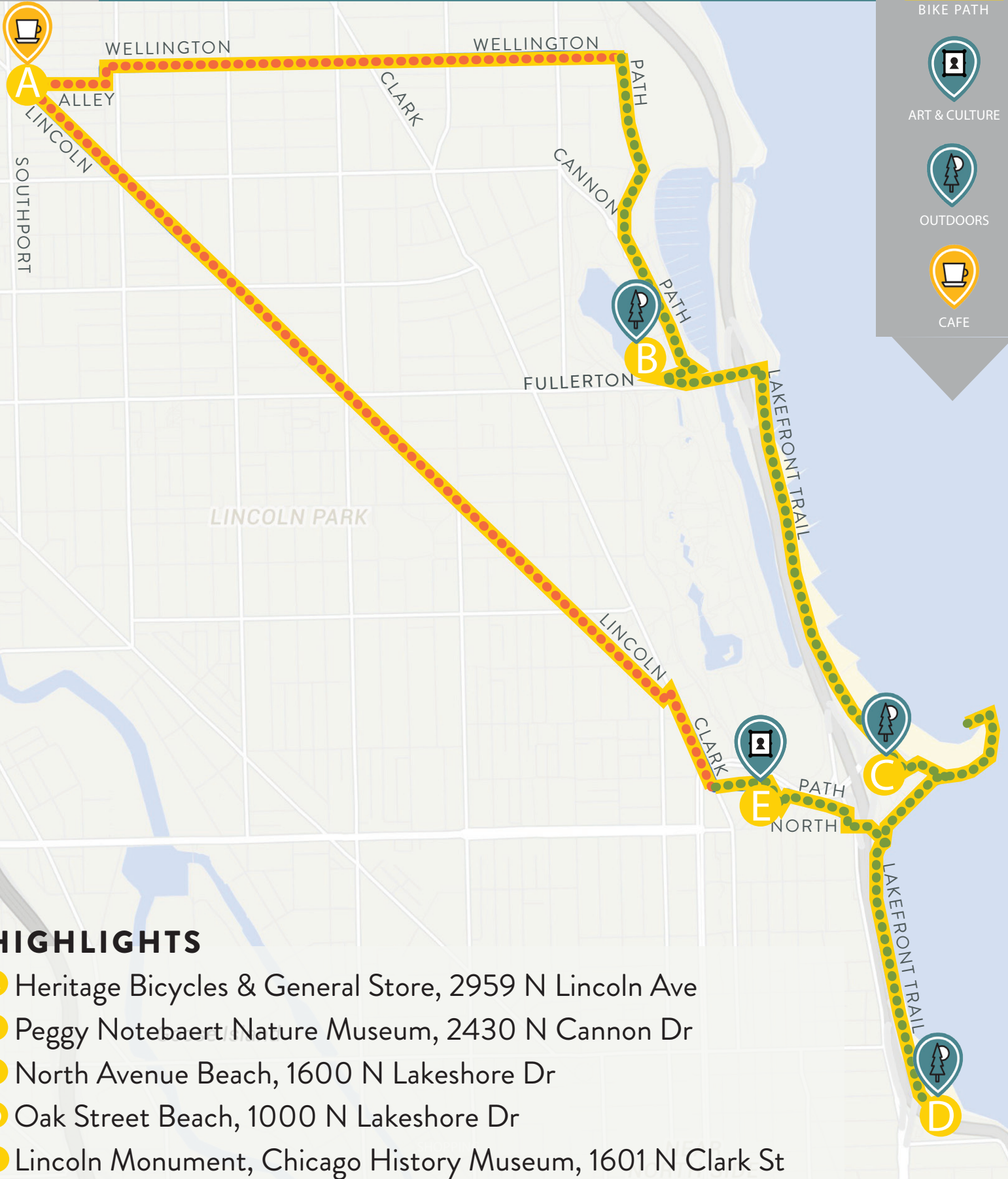

## HIGHLIGHTS

### A HERITAGE BICYCLES & GENERAL STORE

Fuel up for the ride with coffee and a snack while the bike tires get pumped and we get geared up.

### B PEGGY NOTEBAERT NATURE MUSEUM

Beautiful nature preserve in the heart of the city. Birds and wildlife can be viewed with a stunning skyline backdrop. This place looks impressive at anytime of day and the museum is a great place to stop with kids.

### C NORTH AVENUE BEACH

The pointe at North Avenue Beach is bustling with activity in the summer. Castaway's is a ferryliner turned bar, outfitted with bike rental stations and dozens of volleyball courts. Great views and people watching from here.

### D OAK STREET BEACH

This is the destination beach for all of Chicago. Run in the sand and grab a snow-cone from a vendor and take a seat in the shadow of the John Hancock Center as you take in the views.

### E LINCOLN MONUMENT

Right behind the Chicago History Museum stands a 15 foot tall Abraham Lincoln bronze statue. Placed in the center a lush garden, with plenty of benches and grass to stretch out in.
