HIGHLIGHTS

- FIVE LEAVES Start your journey off with a little taste of the Land Down Under right in Greenpoint. Five Leaves is one of the Australian cafes in Brooklyn serving gourmet, Melbourne-style breakfasts. The restaurant opened as a tribute to Heath Ledger, who helped set things up and whose friends still run the show. After your Big Brekkie or Avocado Toast, relax and digest with one of their organic teas. 7 days 8-1am
- B TOBY'S ESTATE Stop in Williamsburg to refuel or perhaps to try your hand at latte art at Toby's Estate, provider of specialty coffee to connoisseurs and hipsters alike. Unlike many of the Australian cafes in Brooklyn, Toby's Estate also offers a variety of courses for aspiring baristas. M-F 7am-7pm / Sa-Su 8am-7pm
- BRUNSWICK Head south east to Bedstuy for some coffee and snacks at Brunswick, one of the third wave Australian cafes in Brooklyn owned by a Melbourne native. Here, you can try authentic Melbourne-style coffee coupled with Australian hospitality. M-F 7:30am-6pm / Sa-Su 9am-6pm
- AUDUBON CENTER Next, make your way West to Prospect Heights and ride along Prospect Park's 3.5 miles of cycling paths. To plan your time in the park and get the most out of your visit, stop at Audubon Center. Th-F 12-5pm / Sa-Su 10am-1pm
- MILK BAR If you're stomach's starting to grumble, hit up Milkbar, an Aussie cafe close to Prospect Park. Check out their selection of fresh salads for a healthy late lunch- or early dinner. M-F 7:30am-6pm / Sa-Su 9am-6pm
- PAPILLIONAIRE BICYCLES Keep on riding to Red Hook to wave back at the Statue of Liberty and check out our bike shop in the process. Tu-Su 12-6pm
- BROOKLYN BRIDGE PARK GREENWAY If you still have some energy, link up with the unfinished Brooklyn Greenway which meanders through Brooklyn Bridge Park.
